

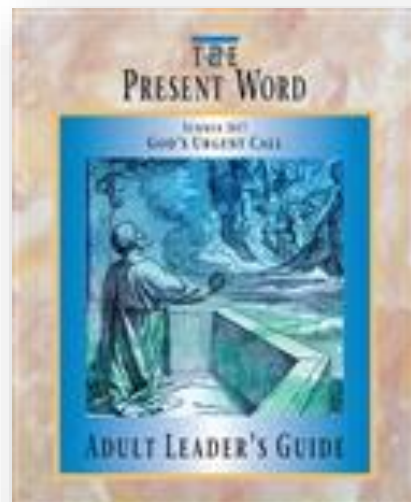

SOME ADULT CURRICULUM IDEAS

1. **“The Present Word”** –Through the exploration of biblical text, adult study groups are invited into a deepened relationship with God. *The Present Word* engages participants in an experiential style of learning—connecting faith and life. This quarterly resource features an Adult Leader’s Guide and an Adult Student’s Book. Discussion and activities encourage participants to live out their faith in their individual and congregational activities.

Based on The Uniform Lesson Series used by five denominations including PC(USA)

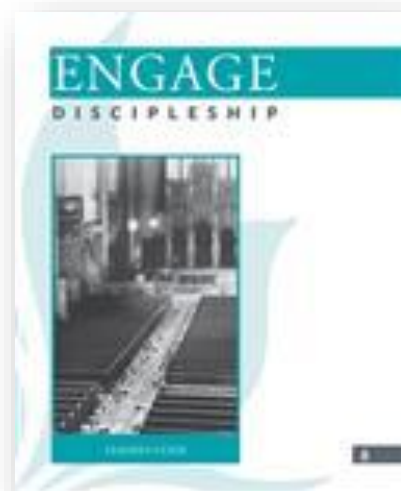

2. **“Engage”** – *Engage* curriculum inspires a journey of prayer and faith-sharing, equips members to live out and share their growing faith, and connects the church with its community. Each seven-session curriculum resource--*Engage: Gospel*; *Engage: Discipleship*; and *Engage: Mission*--was developed in partnership with the Office of Evangelism PC(USA) and Congregational Ministries Publishing.

- This curriculum is more casual in style/approach than *Present Word* which is listed above.



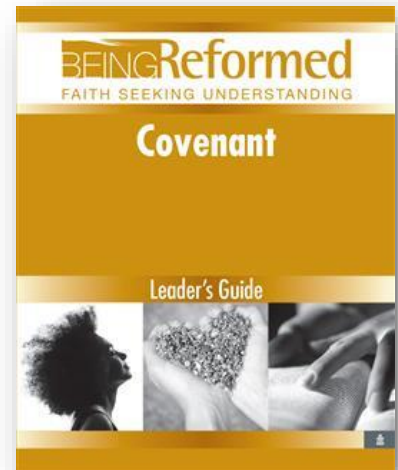

3. “Being Reformed”

Being Reformed: Faith Seeking Understanding is a series of biblically based mini-courses that provides adults with a foundational understanding of the Reformed faith. Each six-session study is written by well-known and respected scholars and features Scripture, prayer, in-depth commentary, and questions for reflection. Each study addresses its subject from a Reformed theological perspective.

- More than 50 titles currently available

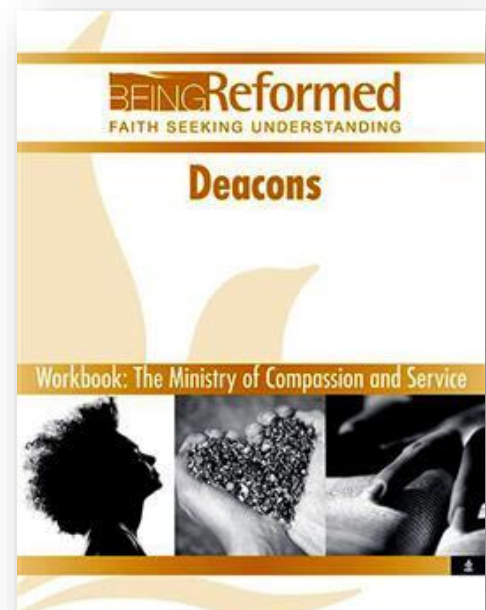
- NEW! “**The Protestant Reformation**” by Donald K. McKim is recommended for all congregations this year – the 500th anniversary of the Protestant Reformation

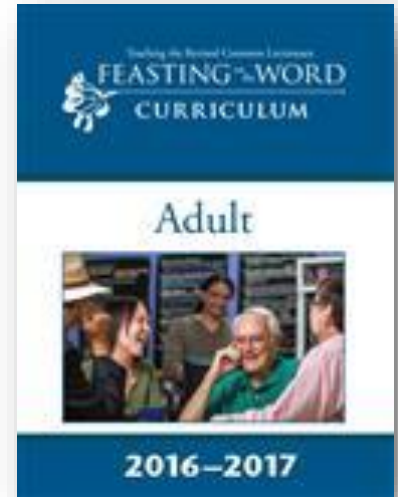


5. “Feasting on the Word” –
